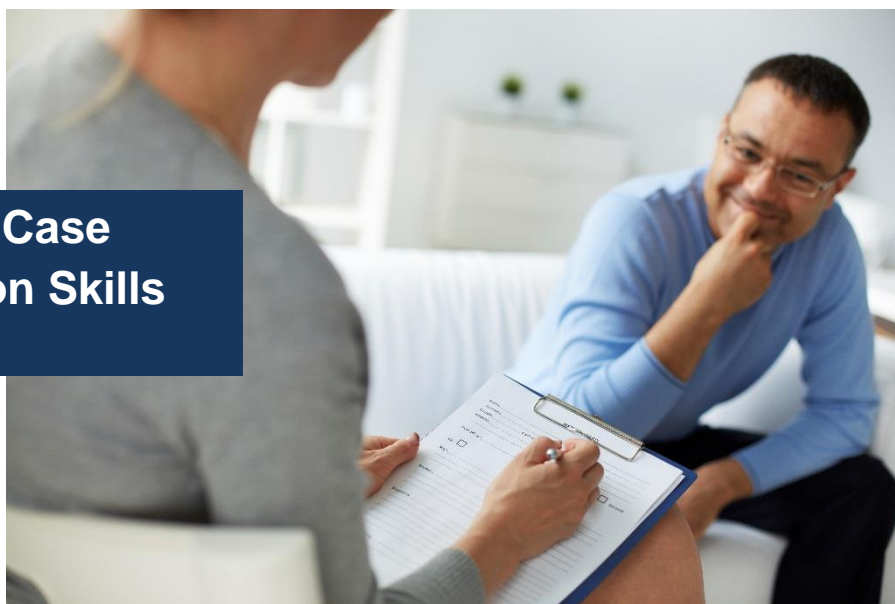


Clinical Case Formulation Skills
